The Chairman of The Friends met with Cllr Nick Worth and the Leader of WLDC [ Cllr Jeff Summers] on Tuesday the 8<sup>th</sup> January 2019 and were informed of the main contents of the report which were embargoed .

On Monday 14<sup>th</sup> of January 2019 @3pm the LCC released information regarding the Future of its Heritage Services into the public domain

On Tuesday 22 January 2019 @ 10am the Chairman is planning to attend the meeting of LCC Scrutiny Committee at County Hall

On Thursday 31 January 2019, the FOHA Committee will meet to transact usual business and there will be an agenda item on the Future of Heritage Services

On 6 February 2019 there is a meeting of representatives of Lincoln Friends groups including FOHA and of other interested parties at Jew's Court, Lincoln to discuss the future of Heritage Services. These meetings have been ongoing for the past two years since it was announced that there was to be a review of heritage services.

During the period of consultation there is an opportunity for individuals and organizations to participate and I would encourage everyone to do so

After the Consultation, a report will be carried out based on the returns and once that has been released LCC EH WLDC & FOHA will meet to discuss the way forward regarding Gainsborough Old Hall, the meeting will hopefully be in the late Spring or early Summer of this year

It is the intention of LCC to cease managing the Old Hall in March 2020, ie in 14 months time
